Project Description

Development, design and layout of a jogging track, drainage, enhanced football facilities and upgrade of field lighting to an existing recreation ground located at Fanny Village, Point Fortin.

Key project parameters

- 345m jogging track
- Football field upgrade of 4,050m²
- Provision of 12 Nr. twin 1500W field lighting standards

Our role

- We were commissioned by SPORTT to carry out the detailed design of the entire field upgrade for the development including jogging track, surface drainage system, field regarding and provision of lighting for night play.
- The entire infrastructure layout was determined in conjunction with the requirements from the Borough Council which specified particular dimensions for football, specification for track and stipulations to maintain existing field facilities such as a children's playground.
- Our design incorporated an efficient approach for the orientation of the jogging track which optimised the use of land space without compromising the space available for football.
- Lighting system was designed to serve the dual purpose of jogging track lighting as well as field lighting - this minimised both capital and operational costs for the Client and Owner in terms of reduced lighting infrastructure.
