Project Description

The project involved the assessment of possible damage to adjacent residential homes after the activities involved in the onshore drilling activities carried out by the Owner.

Following seismic exploration and the potential for onshore gas deposits, the Owner commenced drilling in a rural area of Trinidad. Following land clearance and drilling completions, nearby residents formally complained about cracks and visible signs of distress of their homes.

Our role

- Site visits to detail, catalogue and survey four residential homes that were reported as having damage
- Develop historical data on the sequence of events that may have lead to such distress
- Report on the likely causes of distress and determine to what extent the onshore works would have contributed
- Make recommendations for remedial works
